(On Sec Notes: Up front some special acknowledgments for some special people who went out of their way to make a special event! Eric McKenzie procured some of the special beer and the hares procured the rest with financial support from the hash I believe! The lead hare El Pipila is quoted as saying "At least six types of American beer were served at circle, some quite fancy microbrews that made HashCash Brenda scowl when she realized how many greenbacks were laid out for them." Your onsec never saw Splat scowl however, perhaps the hare was overcome by dehydration from his haring efforts when he thought he observed this! Tickler brought 2 bottles of American whiskey in his usual generous fashion. The On On suffered from some miscommunication in the kitchen. The fare was quite American with imported U.S. hamburgers, bratwurst, ball park "franks" (hot dogs) and kosher vienna sausage. But the advertised barbeque turned out to be frying pans, and the promised baking oven for the American apple pies proved to be a cross between a crock pot and a George Foreman min-grill. sign rd 3278 towards Seri Thai. At 13 km exit left on to Thanon Seri Thai going towards Bang Kapi. Drive straight towards Bang Kapi and you come to the NIDA intersection at 16,9 km. Turn right into Sri Burapa and drive along the lake to Sri Burapa Soi 18 (HHH-sign on your left). Turn left into the soi and park immediately on the right.

NOTE FROM WEBMASTER – these misdirections are a big loop – if you take a look at the map below you will see that you can get there by heading north on Srinakarin and saving maybe 12-14 km. From the expressway, take the Srinakarin (Bangkapi) exit, that's the FIRST Srinakarin Exit. You will now be on Rama IX Road. Carry on to the Srinakarin intersection taking a left, direction Bangkapi. Go all the way on Srinakarin until you get to a T junction. Take a right and this is Serithai. Sriburapha is about 1.5km on the left.
