Chennai Hash celebrates its 10th Anniversary in two different Indian states along the Arabian Sea coast - Kerala & Goa. Kerala, known as "God's Own Country", will be the venue for one run + overnight stay on houseboats and cruising on the backwaters + party. Then hop on a train to Goa for 2 runs + party there.

Hashers have 2 packages – you may opt for either of the one below:-

1. Kerala & Goa (29th Sep-3rd Oct)
2. Only Goa (1st -3rd Oct)

How to get to Trivandrum, Kerala-India

Air Asia, a budget Airline, started their first operations to Tiruchirapalli last year May and November to Trivandrum, Cochin and Kolkata. This year mid-May Air Asia will fly to Chennai, Bangalore, Mumbai, Hyderabad & New Delhi.

Kuala Lumpur-Trivandrum-Kuala Lumpur: Frequency: 1 flight per day, Flight Timing: KUL-TRV (06.20-07.50), TRV-KUL (07.40-14.10). Lowest Fare (round trip, including taxes): RM 303 per person, Highest Fare: (round trip, including taxes): RM 441 per person, the mentioned fare is only a guideline & may be revised from time to time. Traveling by Indian Railways:

India is such a geographically vast country; the best way to reach the innermost regions of the country is through trains. The Indian rail transport is one of the largest and busiest rail networks in the world. It connects almost every city and village in India, covering a total distance of 63,465 km (39,435 miles) in length and 6,800 stations. Sleeper class consists of open plank seats that convert into berths at night. The seats are grouped into sort of semi-private sections of 6 seats, 3+3 facing each other. Most of the long distance trains on the India railway system have this facility. The pantry car serves meals, snacks, coffee, tea (chai), and cool drinks. "Room service" is available, where the train staff brings your order to your seat, although you can go the pantry car and order your meals directly. You will need to pay for what you buy. The food is pretty decent on an express train.



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Hashers are booked on Netravati Express 2nd class sleeper, non a/c. The climate during September-end is comfortable enough to travel in non-a/c coach. Netravati Express starts from Trivandrum Central Station and stops at Lokmanyatilak Station (near Bombay) passing through three states i.e. Kerala, Karnataka & Maharashtra. Hashers will board at Alleppey (also called Alappuzha) Station at 12.50pm on 30th Sept and arrive at Karamali Station (Goa) at 06.30am on 1st Oct. The distance from Alleppey to Karamali is 946 kms.

Train Return Ticket Reservation:

Registration fee includes only one way ticket from Alleppey (Kerala) to Karamali (Goa).

If you need us to book your return ticket from Karamali (Goa) to Trivandrum after the event, we would be glad too. Please mail mexvarma2007@gmail.com with your date of departure from Goa. The return train from Goa departs at 22hrs & reach Trivandrum the next day evening at 18.40 hrs.

Where is Trivandrum:

“God’ Own Country”-Kerala: Thiruvananthapuram (known as Trivandrum) the capital of Kerala. The state of Kerala, a beautiful seaside city built on seven hills, is located on the west coast of India near the extreme South Western tip of the mainland spreading over a total of 2,192sq.km. It is bound by the Arabian Sea on the West and Tamil Nadu on the East. The wooded highlands on the Western Ghats in the Eastern and North Eastern borders with some of the most enchanting picnic spots, a long shoreline, with internationally renowned beaches, historic monuments, backwater stretches and a rich cultural heritage make this district a much sought after tourist destination. Thiruvananthapuram (previously called Trivandrum) is an ancient city with tradition dating back to 1000 BC and became the capital of Raja of Travancore in 1750. The city gets its name from the word, Thiru-anantha-puram, meaning the city of Anantha or the abode of the sacred Serpent Anantha on which Lord Vishnu, the preserver of the Hindu trinity, reclines.

Kerala Backwaters, South India - A Fascinating Journey & Experience!!

Washed by the silvery waves of the Arabian Sea, Alleppey (now "Alappuzha"), is known as the Venice of the East. Kerala, 'God's Own Country', has a long structure of water-body called backwaters, formed by the crisscrossing of 44 rivers flowing across the state. It is a complex network of canals, lakes, lagoons and deltas of these 44 rivers flowing along with the seawater. The complex backwaters stretch for as long as 1900 Km but only 900 Km of this is open for navigation. The backwaters, over centuries, connect the remote villages and cities of Kerala. It used to be the main Trading route among the villages and is still a source of livelihood for many villagers. Kerala is very lush and a vacation in the lap of this greenery is best enjoyed cruising slowly across the backwaters on a houseboat or a canoe. Its calm and serene blue backwaters make an unforgettable travel experience. The Backwater Cruise is popular amongst tourists from all over the world and leaves a lasting impression in the traveler's mind. The large wooden houseboats, called "Kettuvallams" have one or two bed-rooms, a small sitting room, dining and kitchenette, are usually manned by a three member crew. The food cooked on board is local cuisine and served hot. These houseboats cruise along shallow, palm fringed lakes and narrow canals.

16.30hrs: The houseboats will drop hashers at run spot (A to B run in the country side)

17hrs: Run starts

18.30hrs: Circle & Down Down

19.30hrs: Dinner & Party at backwater resort and dance to DJ Vivek's music. Overnight stay on houseboats.

30th Sept 2010-Thursday

09hrs: Check out of houseboat (after breakfast) at Kumaakodi & move to "Coconut Palms" **

11hrs: Early lunch will be served.



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12noon: Coach to Alleppey Railway Station.

12.50hrs: Board Netravati Express train to Karamali (Goa). It's an overnight train journey
