1 On Second Stage Expressway take Rachadapisek exit (2-08)... you will come to a set of traffic lights. After the lights try to shift right and continue on the flyover. On the left is a clock tower and Big C... this is Wongsawang Road. Continue straight to Rama

**Secret Scribe Report ... (Onsec Note – 36 total including 2 hares, 17 men with members, 11 women without members, 3 new boots, and 3 visitors showed up!) Now for this week's prose:**

Meandering along the roadways, twisting & turning here and there, a few HHH signs would have been handy but Ok, that might be too hard. Finally we assembled on the mud-laden open field but nobody really WANTED to be there (like we are not going to get muddy), but there was a patch of clay/gravel so we gravitated there but finally the GM scouted for pavement on a little used road (on a Sunday at least) and there we encamped for the on, and the on after. At least it was bare but not totally dry. The hare, apparently having incurred a broken toe (how is not clear) enlisted the assistance of one or more co-hares to do his bidding in the jungle amidst the mud, blood & beer.

Paper on along a concrete wall and from get go, it was clear this was going to be a messy run having recently rained in the area and 'Big Package' known for his attention to detail (and his GPS') managed to find mud quickly and often. First up was leaping across a small ditch filled with unfathomable colours & fragrances and a leap of faith that THAT was actually the ON as many did NOT want to get their shoes wet so early. Finally, it was ON and some on the reluctant pack followed. A bit more took us to an elevated walkway and the paper led over and down the other side which was a leap down as well and seemingly a one way jump. This led to the first check inside a heavily overgrown area of bush. Now, the pack spread out, many did not want to take that leap and stayed on the concrete but "eventually" it was across the road to the right and through the mud and into the jungle. The pack had no choice but to follow. VII Bridge. Crossing the bridge, keep left and take the first left exit. Loop under the bridge reaching the river and continue. Pass the Police Station on your right and turn right into Route 3215, under Oral-B sign. Turn on your odometer. Continue on this winding road for about 3.2 Km. Turn left into Soi 17; at the entrance to the soi, there's a 7-11 on the left and Tesco Lotus Express on the right. Drive in 800 metres and park in the big parking lot on the left (before the railway bridge).

2 From Taksin Bridge. Cross the Bridge towards Thonburi. Go straight staying right; go over the Taksin Road flyover after 2 Km. At the middle of this flyover zero your odometre. Take the next flyover and then at 3 Km take the Petkasem/ Borom Ratchachonni signposted exit left. After the exit, stay to the right and at 4 Km take the Borom R. Road option staying right. After this, continue straight going over several flyovers until about 16 km... you will reach a major traffic light junction. Turn right (road leads to Rama V bridge) and go straight. Continue until you see sign for Bang Krui-Sai Noi Road... exit to frontage road; continue until you reach traffic lights under the flyover. Turn right into Bang Krui-Sai Noi Road and follow the road until you come to a small roundabout (22.6 km); turn left. At 23.7 km turn right into Soi 17; at the entrance to the soi, there's a 7-11 on the left and Tesco Lotus Express on the right. Drive in 800 metres and park in the big parking lot on the left (before the railway bridge). Please note: It is NOT ADVISABLE to take this option becoz of road works at the Rachapruek-Nakorn Inn traffic light junction.
